## PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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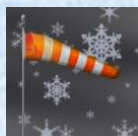
### REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system moves across the Antarctic Peninsula and into the Weddell Sea today. Indications are for strong winds from the west-northwest with periods of precipitation reducing visibility today and tonight. Expect west-northwest winds with precipitation continuing through tomorrow as a high pressure ridge moves in from the west.
