PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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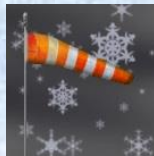
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system continues to oscillate west of the Bellingshausen Sea due to a blocking high pressure ridge strengthening in the Weddell Sea. Indications are for light northerly winds with periods of low visibility due to snow and freezing fog today. Expect north-northeast winds increasing and becoming strong tonight as the pressure gradient increases then decreasing tomorrow as the pattern continues.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5, occasional 1/2-1 in snow, freezing fog/mist, becoming Unrestricted

Wind (kts): Variable 5-10, becoming N-NE-E 10-15 gusts to 20

Max Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 1/2-1 in snow, blowing snow, freezing fog/mist

Wind (kts): NE-E 20-30 gusts to 40, becoming Variable 5-10 late

Min Temp: -4°C / 25°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 1-3 in snow, light fog/mist

Wind (kts): SE-S 10-15 gusts to 20, becoming N-NE 15-20

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F
