**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

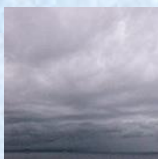
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**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

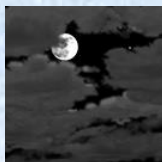
Two low pressure centers on either side of the Antarctic Peninsula will cause each other to weaken through the period and give way to strengthening high pressure in the Weddell Sea. Indications are for east-southeast winds today shifting to the northeast and decreasing as overcast skies become mostly cloudy overnight. The northeasterly winds will usher in colder temperatures late tomorrow.
