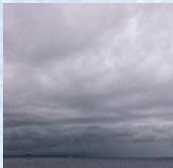
**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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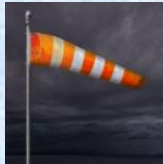
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A low pressure center approaches Anvers Island from the west and draws winds from the east across the Antarctic Peninsula. Indications are for decreasing wind speeds through the day allowing for fog formation then increasing and becoming gusty overnight and into tomorrow. Expect a pattern of reoccurring precipitation late at night into early morning for the next several days.

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 4-6 in light fog, with periods of 1-3 in fog, mist, and drizzle

**Wind (kts):** E-SE 10-15 gusts to 20, becoming E-SE 5-10

**Max Temp:** 3°C / 37°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -5°C / 23°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasional 3-5 in rain/snow showers late

**Wind (kts):** E 8-12, becoming NE-E 15-25 gusts to 30

**Min Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -6°C / 21°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 3-5 in snow showers, occasional 1/2-2 in snow and blowing snow early

**Wind (kts):** NE-E 20-30 gusts to 40

**Max Temp:** 2°C / 36°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -7°C / 19°F
