PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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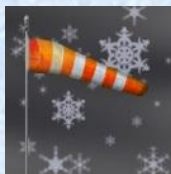
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure ridging along the west coast of the Antarctic Peninsula weakens today and gives way to low pressure moving in from the Bellingshausen Sea. Indications are for favorable weather conditions starting out with partly cloudy skies and light winds, increasing by late afternoon, with snow overnight and into tomorrow as low pressure system moves into the area.

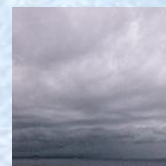

Sky: Partly Cloudy, becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with rain/snow mix late

Wind (kts): N-NE 8-12, becoming N-NE 15-20 gusts to 25

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with periods of 2-4 in snow, rain/snow mix and blowing snow

Wind (kts): N-NE 15-20 gusts to 25, becoming N 8-12

Min Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -6C / 21°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with occasional light rain/snow showers

Wind (kts): SW-W 8-12

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -5°C / 23°F
