**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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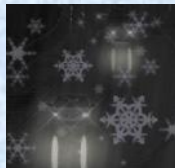
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A low pressure trough over Anvers Island moves to the northeast up the west coast of the Antarctic Peninsula today and is replaced by a high pressure ridge tomorrow. Indications are for precipitation persisting today and overnight ending by early tomorrow as winds continue to decrease and become light and variable through the forecast period.

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 3-5, with periods of 1/2-2 in snow, snow/rain mix, and fog/mist

**Wind (kts):** SW-W 8-12, becoming Variable 4-8

**Max Temp:** 1°C / 34°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -7°C / 19°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, with periods of 3-5 in snow, snow/rain mix, and fog/mist

**Wind (kts):** W-NW 8-12, occasional gusts to 20, becoming Variable 4-8

**Min Temp:** -2°C / 28°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8C / 18°F

**Sky:** Mostly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, with periods of snow showers early

**Wind (kts):** Variable 4-8

**Max Temp:** 1°C / 34°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -5°C / 23°F
