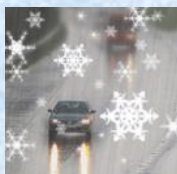
**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A high pressure ridge moves through the Bellingshausen Sea today followed by an intensifying low pressure system tomorrow. Indications are for intermittent precipitation lingering today with light winds overnight, becoming strong and gusty from north-northeast tomorrow as the energy from the low pressure system enters the region.

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, with periods of 3-5 in snow, snow/rain mix, and fog/mist

**Wind (kts):** W-NW 10-15 gusts to 20, becoming Variable 4-8

**Sky:** Mostly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, with occasional snow showers
