## PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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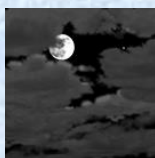
### REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure trough over the west coast of the Antarctic Peninsula gives way to high pressure ridging by the afternoon. Indications are for continued precipitation with gusty north-northeast winds decreasing through the day. Expect a break in cloud cover and precipitation overnight followed by low clouds and precipitation moving in from the southwest early tomorrow as next low pressure trough approaches.

**Sky:** Cloudy, becoming Mostly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, with periods of 3-5 in snow, snow/rain mix, and fog/mist

**Wind (kts):** NE 15-20 gusts to 25, becoming Variable 4-8

**Max Temp:** 1°C / 34°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -6°C / 21°F

**Sky:** Mostly Cloudy, becoming Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted with periods of 4-6 in snow, snow/rain mix, and fog/mist late

**Wind (kts):** NE-E 5-10

**Min Temp:** -2°C / 28°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -6C / 21°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, with periods of 3-5 in snow, snow/rain mix, and fog/mist

**Wind (kts):** E-SE 8-12, becoming SW 10-15 late

**Max Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F
