PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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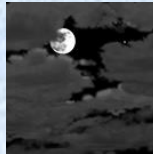
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

An area of low pressure over Anvers Island moves to the northeast today and is replaced by high pressure in the afternoon and through the forecast period. Indications are for precipitation ending by mid-morning with east-southeast winds shifting to the southwest as clouds begin to dissipate. Expect colder temperatures with favorable conditions overnight and into tomorrow.

Sky: Cloudy, becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with periods of 3-5 in snow showers

Wind (kts): E-SE 10-15, becoming S-SW 8-12

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy, becoming Partly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): W-NW 8-12

Min Temp: -5°C / 23°F

Min Wind Chill: -9C / 16°F

Sky: Partly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with periods of 3-5 in early morning freezing fog/mist

Wind (kts): N-NE 5-10

Max Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F
