PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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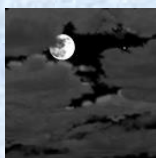
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure is exiting the region to the east with high pressure building over the northern section of the Antarctic Peninsula and the Weddell Sea through the forecast period. Indications are for light winds and favorable conditions today and overnight with increasing cloud cover tomorrow afternoon. Expect light precipitation developing late tomorrow evening as weak area of low pressure forms near Anvers Island.

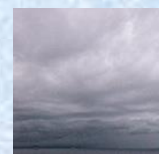
