**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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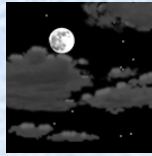
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A high pressure ridge is developing over Anvers Island with high pressure in the Weddell Sea and a low pressure system to the north near Tierra Del Fuego. Indications are for light winds with periods of low clouds, freezing fog/mist, moving in from southwest today. Expect favorable conditions overnight and tomorrow as next low pressure system begins to develop in the Bellingshausen Sea by end of period.
