PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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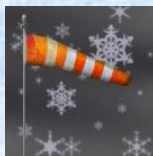
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system passing between Elephant Island and South Georgia Island is the dominant feature in the region today causing southwest flow along the west coast of the Antarctic Peninsula. Indications are for favorable conditions starting out, but by afternoon low pressure developing in the Bellingshausen Sea will cause increased winds and precipitation overnight and tomorrow.

Sky: Partly Cloudy, becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 4-6 in snow late

Wind (kts): N-NE 8-12 gusts to 15

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 4-6, with periods of 1-3 in snow, freezing fog/mist

Wind (kts): W-NW 10-20 gusts to 25

Min Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -7C / 19°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5, with periods of 1/2-2 in snow, rain/snow mix, freezing fog/mist

Wind (kts): W-NW 8-12 gusts to 20, becoming N 15-25 gusts to 30 late

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F
