PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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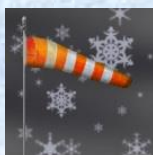
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system develops in the Bellingshausen Sea and moves up the west coast of the Antarctic Peninsula today then moves across the terrain and into the Weddell Sea tomorrow. Indications are for strong northwest-north winds with persistent precipitation today and overnight. Expect similar conditions tomorrow as winds shift to west-northwest with gradual improving conditions late in the period .
