**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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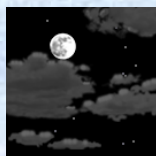
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Clear and cold as a high pressure ridge strengthens along the west coast of the Antarctic Peninsula and a low pressure system exits the Weddell Sea to the northeast. Indications are for southwesterly winds becoming easterly today as temperatures decrease significantly through the forecast period.
