PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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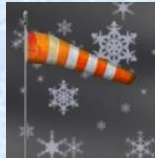
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system moves southeastward through the Southern Ocean today with the low center approaching Adelaide Island by the end of the forecast period. Indications are for strong north-northeast winds persisting through tomorrow with occasional gusts over 50 knots today. Expect periods of precipitation becoming more persistent tonight with periods low visibility as temperatures gradually increase above freezing through tomorrow.
