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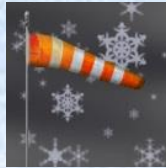
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A Low Pressure System impacts the Antarctic Peninsula today with overcast skies, snow and blustery winds. Poor conditions are expected to continue to envelope Anvers Island through the entire forecast period.
