PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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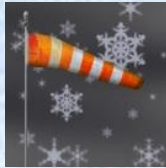
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A cold front associated with the low over the Bellingshausen Sea is supports snow showers, gusty winds, and overcast skies. Worsening conditions are expected overnight as the front passes. By midday tomorrow, the front will have become disorganized and its remnants will be in the Weddell sea. Sunday afternoon expect lighter winds and breaks in overcast skies.

Visibility (SM): 4-6 due to light snow and blowing snow; occasionally 1-2 due to light snow, blowing snow, and patchy sea fog early morning

Wind (kts): W-NW 15-20 gusting 30; becoming W-NW 15-20

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F
