**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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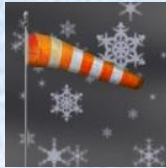
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Fragments of the front that passed over the Antarctic Peninsula yesterday continue to produce wet and blustery conditions for the station this morning. These conditions are expected to continue through the forecast period as the next low pressure system approaches the Island.

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** < 1-2 due to mixed snow and rain

**Wind (kts):** N 15-25 gusting 35

**Max Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -11°C / 12°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** < 1 due to mixed snow and rain

**Wind (kts):** N 25-35 gusting 55

**Min Temp:** -2°C / 28°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -12°C / 10°F

**Sky:** Cloudy, becoming mostly cloudy by mid morning

**Visibility (SM):** < 1 due to snow, becoming 3-5 due to light mixed snow and rain by morning

**Wind (kts):** NW-W 25-35 gusting 50, becoming SW 15-20 gusting to 25 by evening

**Max Temp:** -1°C / 30°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -16°C / 3°F
