PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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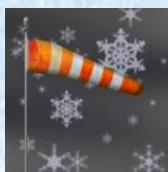
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Remnants of yesterday's passing frontal boundary continues to impact the Anvers Island, causing gusty winds, mixed precipitation, and occasional periods of foggy conditions. The quasi-stationary low in the Bellingshausen Sea will continue to weaken allowing for tapering winds tomorrow evening, though showery light mixed precipitation will continue well into the weekend due to its position.
