**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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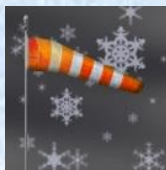
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A low pressure system in the Bellingshausen Sea lays against the base of the Antarctic Peninsula this morning bringing wet and blustery weather to Anvers Island. These conditions are expected to continue through tomorrow with wind speeds increasing to gusts of 60 knots by tomorrow morning.
