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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

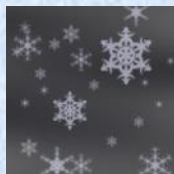
A low pressure system transiting the Drake Passage today will bring extensive cloudiness to Anvers Island this afternoon and light precipitation starting this evening. These conditions are expected to continue through Saturday morning.

Sky: Partly cloudy, becoming mostly cloudy by mid-afternoon

Visibility (SM): 3-5 due to light mixed snow and rain, occasionally < 1 due to mixed snow and rain

Sky: Cloudy, becoming partly cloudy by early Saturday morning

Visibility (SM): 3-5 due to light mixed snow and rain, occasionally < 1 due to mixed snow and rain, becoming unrestricted early Saturday morning

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F
