REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A deep trough associated with a low that recently passed over Drake Passage is expected to support cloudy conditions and occasional periods of light snow for Anvers Island. Though higher pressure does move in over the next 48 hours, another low is expected to develop north of the peninsula drawing in additional waves of moisture towards the island tomorrow morning.
