

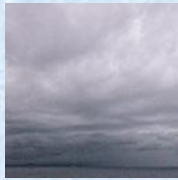

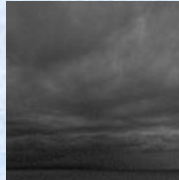
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Another wet and gusty day for your Thursday. As a low in the Bellingshausen Sea extends a trough over the Antarctic peninsula. Winds will begin to taper off to light and variable by tomorrow morning. Precipitation will continue to be off and on through the forecast period.

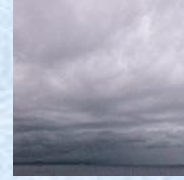

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 1-2 due to light mixed rain and snow

Wind (kts): NNW-N 10-15 gusting 20

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-2, becoming Unrestricted by late evening

Wind (kts): N-NNE 10-15

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 1-2 due to light mixed rain, snow and fog by mid-evening

Wind (kts): Variable 2-7

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F
