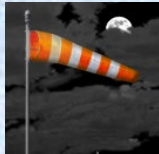
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Skies and weather should break this afternoon, evening as a ridge of high pressure slips quickly across the area. Expect higher wind speeds after midnight through tomorrow as low pressure starts the trek into and across Drake's Passage...

Sky: Cloudy becoming Partly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 snow, becoming Unrestricted

Wind (kts): W-NW 10-15, becoming Variable 5

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): Variable 5, becoming NE-E 25-40

Min Temp: -4°C / 25°F

Min Wind Chill: -15°C / 5°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional light snow

Wind (kts): E-SE 35-50, becoming E-SE 20-30

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -16°C / 3°F
