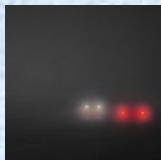
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A ridge of high pressure is keeping things on the more pleasant side today. A slight breeze, mist, and some occasional snow/sleet is in store through tonight. Tomorrow, the winds will pick up later in the day ahead of an incoming low to the southwest of Anvers Island.
