**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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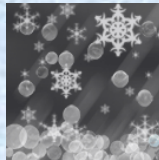
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A low pressure system will push into the southern Antarctic Peninsula, sweeping another round of clouds, snow, and breezy winds across Anvers Island. Temperatures will remain fairly stable, but wind chills will continue to drop into the double digit temperatures at times.
