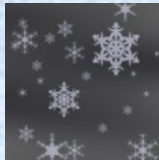
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure is exiting the region, leaving winds, clouds, and snow in its wake. Snow and winds will both diminish later tonight ahead of the next incoming low later tomorrow. Southwesterly winds will also keep things on the cooler side. Happy Friday the 13th!

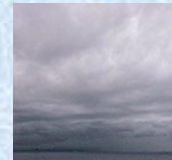

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1 – 3 due to snow, blowing snow, and mist, occasionally Unrestricted

Wind (kts): SW 15-25, gusting to 30, becoming SW 10-20

Max Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -20°C / -4°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 3 – 5 due to snow and mist

Wind (kts): SW 15-20, becoming Light and Variable

Min Temp: -9°C / 16°F

Min Wind Chill: -19°C / -2°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): Light and Variable, becoming NE 10-15

Max Temp: -5°C / 23°F

Min Wind Chill: -18°C / 0°F
