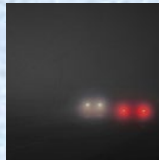
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A weak low pressure center is moving into the area today. Snow will slowly taper off, giving way to a slight bump in the winds later tonight. Temperatures will also warm quite noticeably. Tomorrow, as the low continues to weaken and pass by, the winds will drop again and mist will begin to move in.

**Sky:** Mostly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 2 – 4 due to light snow and mist, becoming Unrestricted

**Wind (kts):** Light and Variable

**Max Temp:** -7°C / 19°F

**Sky:** Mostly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasionally 3 – 5 due to mist

**Wind (kts):** Light and Variable, becoming NE 10-15

**Min Temp:** -7°C / 19°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -15°C / 5°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasionally 2 – 4 due to light snow and mist

**Wind (kts):** NE 10-15, becoming Light and Variable

**Max Temp:** -2°C / 28°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -15°C / 5°F
