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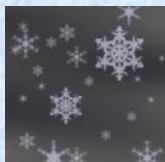
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low's frontal system approaches Anvers Island causing steadily increased gusty winds and periods of heavier snowfall midday into the evening hours. Tomorrow, conditions are expected to improve throughout the morning hours.

Visibility (SM): 3 – 5 due to snow, occasionally 1 – 3 due to light snow and fog

Wind (kts): NE-E 10-15

Min Temp: -5°C / 23°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 4 – 6 due to light snow

Wind (kts): N-NE 05-10

Max Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F
