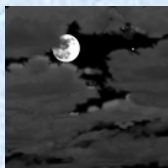
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A ridge following the previous frontal system moves over the region allowing for fair weather and light winds. Tomorrow, a strong low pushes towards the peninsula increasing winds steadily from the early afternoon onwards. Expect gusty winds and heavy snow with frontal passage overnight tomorrow.
