REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure center transits toward the Antarctic Peninsula today bringing gusty winds and blowing snow for early tomorrow morning. Light snow and colder temperatures will be the norm through the entire forecast.

Sky: Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1/2-2 due to snow and sleet, becoming 4-6 mid-morning

Wind (kts): NE 8-12, becoming Light and Variable by mid-morning

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 2-4 due to light snow and blowing snow

Wind (kts): Light and Variable, becoming NNE 10-15, gusting to 20 by early morning

Min Temp: -7°C / 19°F

Min Wind Chill: -15C / 5°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy, becoming Partly Cloudy by late morning

Visibility (SM): 1-3 due to light snow and blowing snow

Wind (kts): ESE 25-35, gusting to 50

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -24°C / -11°F
