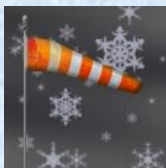
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure center progresses towards the Antarctic Peninsula today causing gusty winds and blowing snow today. Cold air from the peninsula will significantly lower surface temps. Strong winds will persist until tomorrow evening.

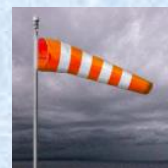

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 4-6 due to light snow and blowing snow, becoming 1-3 due to light snow and blowing snow

Wind (kts): E 15-25, gusting 35; becoming ESE 25-35, gusting to 50

Max Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -19°C / -1°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 2-4 due to light snow and blowing snow

Wind (kts): ESE 20-30, gusting to 45

Min Temp: -9°C / 16°F

Min Wind Chill: -22C / -8°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, drifting snow

Wind (kts): ESE 20-30

Max Temp: -7°C / 19°F

Min Wind Chill: -18°C / 0°F
