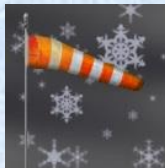
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Remnants of the low that passed through the Antarctic Peninsula yesterday continues to impact Anvers Island with extensive cloud cover and light snow. High pressure moves over the region later tonight bringing fair skies with the sunrise.

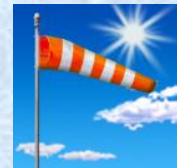
