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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure moves over the Palmer Archipelago today following behind the low pressure system transiting eastward out of the Drake Passage. Fair skies and blustery winds will continue for Anvers Island through early Sunday evening.

Visibility (SM): 2-4 due to blowing snow, becoming unrestricted by late evening

Wind (kts): SE 10-20 gusting to 25, becoming ENE 5-10 by late evening

Min Temp: -8°C / 18°F

Min Wind Chill: -18°C / 0°F

Sky: Partly Cloudy, becoming Mostly Cloudy by late evening

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, 1/2 -1 due to light snow by late evening

Wind (kts): Variable 5-10

Max Temp: -4°C / 25°F

Min Wind Chill: -14°C / 7°F
