**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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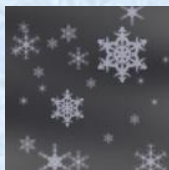
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Fair weather conditions are expected until the late evening hours when a large swath of low-level moisture reaches Anvers Island, directed by a High off the coast of Chile. Snowfall will cause steadily deteriorating visibility until tomorrow evening. Gusty winds are expected to cause intermittent periods of blowing snow starting midday tomorrow.
