PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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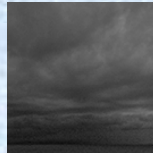
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

An area of relative low pressure will be passing across the Antarctic Peninsula providing enough instability and moisture to bring snow showers and low clouds across Anvers Island today. Winds will remain relatively light throughout the period with clouds starting to clear out throughout the day tomorrow as high pressure becomes the predominant feature.
