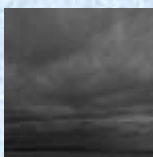
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The ridge of high pressure extended through the Drake Passage prevented the expected increase in winds yesterday, but the clouds and snow did make it into the region and are expected to continue today. The snow will dissipate overnight, but stratus cloudiness will remain through tomorrow night.
