**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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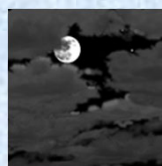
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

The high pressure system continues to move past the tip of the Antarctic Peninsula but continues to maintain mild temperatures and wind speeds around Palmer Station. Cloudy skies and light winds will remain throughout the evening. Tomorrow a weak trough brings in enough moisture for terrain-induced snowfall in the afternoon.
