Tomorrow a low pressure system forms and starts to move towards Anvers Island, tightening the pressure gradient, which will bring in higher winds from the southeast in the afternoon.

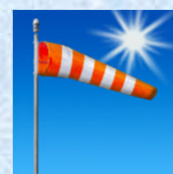
