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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The high pressure system starts to migrate towards the Drake Passage while a low pressure system moves along the coast across the Bellingshausen Sea towards Anvers Island. A light amount of snowfall will linger in the morning followed by some cloud coverage. Tomorrow the low approaches Anvers Island from the Southeast, bringing in snowfall.
