A developed low pressure system continues to hug the coast as it moves through the Bellingshausen Sea. The low will cause the winds to increase and bring in significant snowfall. The visibility will drop periodically throughout the entire forecast period due to snow and blowing snow with temperatures remaining steady throughout the forecast period.
