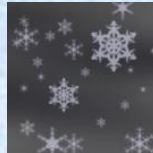
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The weather pattern over the next few days will feature fast moving systems. Mild, humid conditions, with a chance of snow, are expected today. A modest cold front will move through the station late tonight, followed by a brief period of cooler temperatures and light west winds. A rather large and intense low pressure system will approach the Antarctic Peninsula from the west on Monday, preceded by periods of moderate snow, increasing northerly winds, and milder temperatures.
