PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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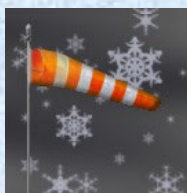
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A series of migratory low pressure systems will continue to propagate through the flow near the Larsen Ice Shelf bringing continued snowfall and elevated winds speeds across Anvers Island. Expect warmer temperatures but because of the wind speeds colder than usual wind chills as these systems pass through.
