**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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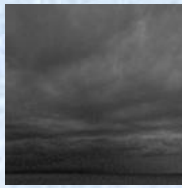
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A low pressure system in the Bellingshausen Sea will weaken as it moves across the Antarctic Peninsula. Snow will end early on Tuesday morning, but winds will linger for the day. Winds will weaken overnight, leaving Wednesday with partly cloudy skies and light winds.
