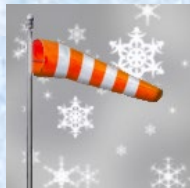
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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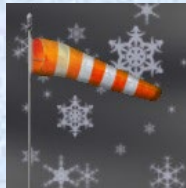
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A deep low pressure system is moving west to east in the Bellingshausen Sea south of the station. This system continues to dump heavy snow and with the strong gusty winds, blowing snow, thus reducing visibility. Once the low runs into land, it dissipates, the snow ends, winds decrease, and it ushers in some colder air.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 w/snow & blowing snow

Wind (kts): NW-N 15-20 gusts to 30

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Visibility (SM): 2-4 w/snow & blowing snow, becoming 4-6 w/snow

Wind (kts): NW-N 10-20 gusts to 25

Min Temp: -6°C / 21°F

Min Wind Chill: -15°C / 5°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5 w/snow & blowing snow, becoming Unrestricted w.snow ending

Wind (kts): S-SW 10-20 gusts to 25, decreasing to E-SE 10-15

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -2°C / 10°F
