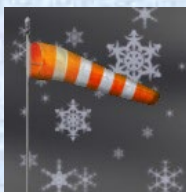
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A dynamic low pressure system is expected to transition across the Antarctic Peninsula today and as a result you can expect rain and snow mixed along with strong northerly winds today and tonight and starting to lighten up tomorrow as the station transitions for a brief period of favorable conditions.
