The large low pressure system that caused all the havoc on station yesterday has pushed across the peninsula and is currently in the Weddell Sea. Conditions will be fair today as relative high pressure temporarily builds and until the next system approaches the station tomorrow and brings another bout of precipitation and clouds.

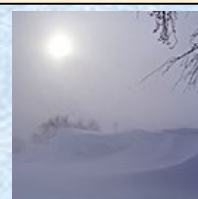
