PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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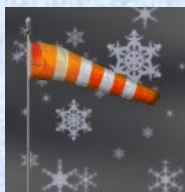
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

An intensifying low pressure system moves in from the west and into the Bellingshausen Sea causing strong northerly winds and persistent precipitation, heavy at times, continuing through today and tonight. Indications are for decreasing winds and precipitation tomorrow as the low pressure system weakens and moves across the Antarctic Peninsula to the south of Anvers Island.
