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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The dynamic low pressure system in the Bellingshausen Sea is slowly weakening but remaining largely stationary and as a result winds will weaken but precipitation and clouds will persist across the area. This low will fill and be absorbed into the pattern later today, but will be followed by another transient low which will provide enough moisture and instability to keep rain/snow mix and cloudy conditions across Anvers Island throughout the period.
