A high pressure ridge to the northeast of Anvers Island weakens and moves to the east-southeast as a low-pressure system to the north near the Falkland Islands intensifies. Indications are for low level clouds today with a chance of precipitation late. Expect steady precipitation tonight ending early tomorrow with cloudy skies persisting and light winds as the high pressure ridge weakens and moves into the Weddell Sea.
